

Tournament Security Procedure during the COVID-19 pandemic

§ 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. This procedure applies to all persons present at the premises where the tournament takes place during the COVID-19 coronavirus epidemic.
2. The purpose of the procedure is to minimize the risks of COVID-19 infection.
3. The procedure defines the actions and preventive measures that will minimize the possibility of infection, but despite all the safety measures taken, it does not allow to completely eliminate the risk associated with coronavirus infection.
4. All persons participating in the tournament during the epidemic are required to complete and submit the declaration constituting Appendix 1, as well as update the information contained therein.
5. Only healthy people without any symptoms (cough, runny nose, abdominal pain, diarrhea, vomiting, conjunctivitis, skin inflammation, infectious disease) come to the facility and participate in the tournament.

§ 2 ORGANIZATIONAL RULES AND RULES OF HEALTH AND SAFETY

1. The tournament is held on the premises of the facility:
 1. max. 150 players (75 pairs) plus tournament staff, (minimum space per participant 4m²,
 - 2.with social distance at least 1.5 meters)
1. When dancing in pairs, there is no social distance of at least 1.5 meters
2. Participants staying in the facility during the tournament are not required to use helmets (masks), provided they keep a social distance of at least 1.5 meters
3. Items and equipment that cannot be cleaned or disinfected should be removed from the venue where the tournament takes place. Necessary accessories should be thoroughly cleaned or disinfected after each use.
4. The dance hall and changing rooms where the participants stay should be at least once ventilated between the blocks, and a constant, high-efficiency air flow in the facility's ventilation system should be ensured in the dance hall.
5. It is not possible to admit participants to the tournament and work by staff who have had contact with a person confirmed or suspected to be infected with COVID-19 in the last 14 days, as well as all people showing symptoms of respiratory tract infection.
6. In the facility, in a designated zone, the temperature is measured with a non-contact thermometer for both participants and tournament staff. Temperature above 37 degrees disqualifies the participant from the possibility of participating in the tournament. In the case of service, he is not allowed at the workplace. Additionally, the temperature is measured in the event of disturbing disease symptoms. A person delegated to measure the temperature of people entering the facility from the outside is equipped with at least a visor or mask and gloves.

§ 3 TAKING HYGIENE AND SANITARY ACTIVITIES

1. At the entrance to the facility, there is a hand disinfection zone - obligatory for adults and children over 6 years of age entering the facility.
2. In the building, one room is separated and marked for the ISOLATORY, equipped with a protective package (masks, gloves,) or a surface ensuring a distance of at least 2 meters from other people on each side.
3. The facility is equipped with alcohol-based hand and surface disinfectants (minimum 60%).

4. The staff of the venue is obligated to regularly disinfect frequently used usable areas and equipment used by participants. In particular, it is important to:

1. regularly clean common areas, including door and window handles, handrails, countertops, chair backs, door frames and wings, handles,
2. disinfect touch surfaces such as keyboard and mouse, light switches and toilets - at least 4 times a day,
3. in particular, such activities should be performed after the end of each dance block and before the start of the next one.
 1. In the kitchen and in the place designated for eating a meal, disinfectants are used for cleaning surfaces and equipment in gastronomy.

§ 4 THE TOURNAMENT'S SERVICE OBLIGATIONS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1. People operating the tournament, inter alia:

1. explain to participants what rules apply in the facility during the epidemic,
2. systematically remind participants of the hygiene rules regarding: washing their hands before eating, after using from the toilet, covering the face while sneezing or coughing credibly, avoiding touching the eyes or mouth,
3. notify the medical staff about disturbing symptoms noticed by the participant,
4. disinfection of surfaces touched by the participants - handrails, door handles, light switches, handles, table tops, desks, equipment, chair rails,
5. are obliged to maintain high hygiene, washing and disinfecting workstations.

§ 5 OBLIGATIONS OF THE TOURNAMENT'S PARTICIPANTS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1. Compliance with the procedures in force in institutions related to increased sanitary rigor in the conditions of the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. Entering the premises of the venue:

1. absolutely at each entrance to the venue, disinfect your hands with a disinfectant,
2. undergo a non-contact temperature measurement.

1. Registration:

- a. Have your own pen to fill in the obligatory declaration from Appendix 1 (for the forgetful, registration will have pens at the price of PLN 10 / item),
2. keep social distance at least 1.5 m from other people,
3. if possible, have a deducted amount to be paid,
4. not submit starter books for registration,
5. check the correctness of the issued bib number and any blocks before collecting them,
6. after the starts, return the bib number in the presence of a person from the reception to a designated container (starting numbers will be used once during the tournament).

1. During the tournament:

1. reduce the time spent in the cloakroom to a minimum, and leave the cloakroom during the airing,
2. not leave the facility without a clear need,
3. avoid phone calls in the presence of other people,
4. meals and drinks (also your own) eat only in a designated place,
5. do not sit in the audience excluded from use,
6. follow the instructions of the tournament staff.

1. The course of the competition:

1. The organizer does not plan a collective presentation, the pairs will be presented successively during the competition,

2. The organizer does not plan collective photos,
3. The place for decorating pairs will be spacious enough, and the final pairs will be invited to the dance floor by individual categories,
4. decorators will present diplomas, cups and medals; the dancers will be asked to put the medals on their necks,
5. we express mutual congratulations and thanks with a bow.

§ 6 PROCEDURE IN CASE OF A SUSPECTED CORONAVIRUS INFECTION

1. A staff member or participant who notices symptoms of respiratory tract infection in other people or himself, immediately informs the tournament's medical staff.
2. In the event that a participant or a staff member develops symptoms suggesting coronavirus infection, this person is isolated in a designated place.
3. A person suspected of being infected with coronavirus puts on a mask and gloves in the ISOLATORY or in a designated place.
4. In the event of a participant's poor condition (breathing problems), the medical service calls 999 or 112.
5. The Tournament Manager notifies the participant or the staff member of the suspected coronavirus infection at the sanitary and epidemiological station tel. + 48 222 500 115 and applies to guidelines.
6. The Tournament Manager notifies the other participants and staff who had contact with the sick about the crisis situation, procedures are applied in accordance with the instructions of the poviát (county) epidemiological station.
7. The area where the person suspected of being infected with the coronavirus has moved and stayed is subject to cleaning and disinfection. engages in cleaning and disinfection.

§ 7 FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The security procedure is valid during the Airdance Summer Festival 2021 dance tournament in Warsaw and applies to all participants and staff.
2. The security procedure was approved by the Tournament Manager and the Board.
